POST GRADUATE MEMBERSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The candidate must have satisfactorily completed an accredited residency training program in otolaryngology-head and neck surgery acceptable to the American Board of Otolaryngology.
2. The candidate shall be an otolaryngologist-head and neck surgeon of great personal integrity and high ethical standards.

APPLICATION/PROPOSAL PROCESS FOR NEW MEMBERS

1. A qualified candidate may become a Post Graduate member by application. Applications may be submitted at any time during the year.
2. A Postgraduate applicant must have a letter of recommendation from two Active Fellows of the Society (proposers). It is preferable that at least one proposer reside in the vicinity in which the applicant practices. The proposers should know the candidate personally and be fully aware of his/her credentials.
3. The application form must be completed by the applicant and accompanied by: (1) a current curriculum vitae; (2) a letter from the proposers; (3) a current photograph; (4) check for dues in the amount of \$85.
4. After receipt of all required materials, the applicant will be confirmed as a Post-Graduate Member of the Triological Society. A subscription to *The Laryngoscope* will be sent to the member upon receipt of dues. The Council reserves the final decision on the qualifications of any applicant.
5. Post graduate membership is for a maximum of 4 years beyond formal residency training.

- Letter of recommendation from Proposer

- Applicant recent photo
- \$85.00 annual dues payment
